Article 15- You have the right to choose your own friends and join or set up groups, as long as it isn't harmful to others.

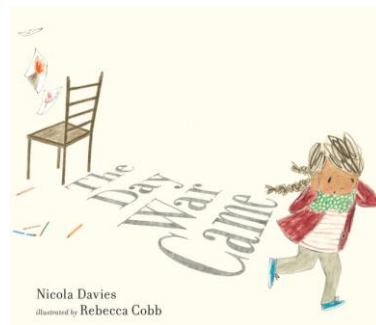
## Stay Safe Week
