

## Kirklevington Primary School Pupil Premium

In Financial Year 2018/2019, our school has received **£13,200** Pupil Premium funding.

This money received has been identified within the budget and is being used to supplement the funds needed to provide:

**£7870** towards:

1-1 and small group targeted support within Reception, Year 1, Year 2, Year 3, Year 4, Year 5 and Year 6 during the school day delivered by TA's. Impact: identified children are making progress in intervention areas.

Additional teaching staff ensuring smaller class group sizes:

Nursery	up to 26 children with 1 Teacher and TA
Reception	18 children
Year 1/2	23 children
Year 2/3	23 children
Year 4/5	27 children
Year 5/6	28 children

**£2000** contribution towards Psychological Services for provision of children's therapist and/or Educational Psychologist to work with individuals, groups and parents as appropriate.

**£1330**

To pay for CPOMS software and Sound Training.

**£1000** to purchase resources to support learning

**£500** to assist with access to After School Clubs, music tuition and Visits.

**£500** to assist families with uniform costs

### **Data for Pupil Premium**

There was only one child eligible for Pupil Premium at the end of Key Stage 1 in each year 2018, 2017 and 2016. 2/3 of these children were working at the expected standard in Reading, Writing and Maths.

There were only 2 pupils in the 2016 Year 6 cohort who was in receipt of Pupil Premium, one of which was given an EHCP in the Summer Term. 1/2 children achieved CRWM at the expected standard. There were 3 pupils in the 2017 cohort. 1/3 achieved CRWM at the higher standard. In 2018 there was only 1 pupil, who also had complex needs and went on to get an EHCP.

Statistical comparisons are not, therefore, appropriate.
