Uniform

The children do look very smart in school uniform at the start of term! Please can I remind parents that leggings are not permitted.

Please make sure that children have a coat/raincoat as the weather is changeable.

We have a 'no jewellery' policy for safety reasons. Small stud earrings may be worn, however must be removed on PE days.

Please ensure items are named, we already have a vast amount of lost property.

Small bags are preferred, our cloakrooms are not big enough for larger items.

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PE kits

A reminder that plain, non-branded PE kits are needed in school. This helps us particularly when children are representing the school at festivals and events.

Our PE kit consists of:



- Navy jogging bottoms
- Navy shorts
- Navy hoody or zip up—plain, no sports brands please
- White t-shirt
- Non-marking trainers/plimsolls
- No branded clothing, leggings or football shirts are allowed
- A PE bag

Please ensure items are named.

PE kits should be brought in on a Monday and taken home on a Friday.

Medication

Any changes to health needs should be reported to school. Please also make sure that your child has any medication needed. All medication needs to be signed in at the office.

School Lunches

The school office must be notified if children change from school lunch to packed lunch or vice versa. This is for ordering and charging purposes.

We ask that children only change between school dinner and packed lunch at the start of each half term and stick to this choice for the whole half term.

Breakfast Club

All children are welcome at breakfast club and places must be booked and paid for in advance. Sessions cost £4. and Breakfast Club starts at 7.45am until the start of school. Please book children on to the system prior to attending so that we can ensure we have enough adults to supervise and for purchasing breakfast items. We have to abide by ratios and we would hate to have to turn anyone away. Any problems with the booking system, please let us know at the office.

Arbor—our new online information system

Our new online system 'Arbor' is now in place. Please make sure that you have access to this. If you have any problems, please come to the school office and we will do our best to help you.

Amongst other things, Arbor is now used for:

- Attendance
- All online payments (balances have now been carried over from school gateway, which is now closed)
- Booking clubs and making payments
- Securely storing personal details about your child, such as contact information
- Sending out communications

Dinner and Breakfast Club payments

Payments should be received weekly via our Arbor app. Some users may find the website easier to navigate. Please contact the office if you need any help.

All previous balances have been transferred to Arbor—please ignore any figures on the old school gateway, as this is no longer used or updated by the school.

Tapestry and Seesaw

Parents should have received log-in information for children's accounts.

Tapestry is used in Nursery and Reception and Seesaw from Birch to Oak. Please ensure you log in at home to keep up to date with school life.


