

Regarding the other planned strike dates, further communications will be shared with parents nearer the time.


We will give parents as much advanced notice as possible, if school is affected.


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Chestnut Class enjoyed being scientists this week. They carefully observed rocks and made scientifically labelled diagrams to show their findings.
