As you know, Kirklevington Primary (along with all schools) are having an increased effort at improving school attendance. Our whole-school attendance is currently **95.9%** which is just above

National (94.3%) but is low for Kirklevington. Please remember that all children should be in school unless they are ill or attending necessary

medical appointments and we ask that all appropriate medical evidence is shared with the school office. We would also like to **remind you that all holidays should be taken outside of term time** and those requested will be unauthorised (unless there are exceptional circumstances). If holidays are of 10 or more sessions, or if your child has persistent absence, we will work with parents to support attendance but if there's no improvement these will be referred to the Attendance Team at Stockton Borough Council. To raise the profile of attendance in school, as well as having a weekly Class Attendance Awards, we are introducing an *Improved Class Attendance of the Month Award*. This will be

announced in assembly and within our newsletters. The class who wins will receive a prize of their choosing from their 'Spin the Wheel' in class. Here's to a *fabulous* February! Mrs Peacock

Breaking News...

Pupils from our school have been selected to take part in the new DfE Five to Twelve study!

Five to Twelve is a new national study involving around 8,000 children attending Primary School in the 2020s and their families. The study will explore how children are getting on in a range of areas in the post-pandemic context. By following children and their families over time, the study aims to provide a contemporary understanding of how children's environments and experiences impact on their future education and wellbeing outcomes.

For the first stage of the study, the National Centre for Social Research (NatCen), which is delivering the study on behalf of DfE, sent letters to the parents or carers of the selected children at their home address in October 2023. The information posted to families listed the various ways they can get in touch with the study team, should they have questions about participating or opting out.
